Pte C.R. BROWNE.

Son of T. Browne Esq. was born at Birregurra on 28th May 1899, and attended schools at Birregurra and Lorne.

Enlisting on 28th Sept 1917, he was trained in Camps at Seymour and Broadmeadows.

He embarked on S.S. Port Darwin, 12th Sept. 1918 with reinforcements to 2nd Field Engineers.

He returned to Australia on S.S. Burma 29th Aug 1919.

Pte L.H. CLISSOLD

Son of S. Clissold Esq. was born in Lorne on 21st Nov. 1896 and attended the Lorne School. Prior to enlistment he was a salesman in Melbourne.

Enlisting on 23rd Aug. 1916 he embarked on S.S. Ballarat 9th Feb 1917 with reinforcements to 8th Batt. Fought in battles at Passchendaele and subsequent engagements and was wounded 18th April 1918.

Sailed for Australia on S.S. Nestor 12th Dec 1918 and was discharged medically unfit.

✚ Pte S.E. CLISSOLD.

Son of S. Clissold Esq- was born in Lorne. Prior to the war he was a coach driver.

He enlisted on 2nd April 1915 and was in camp at — Broadmeadows. He sailed to Egypt on SS Wandilla and fought on Gallipoli; being seriously wounded at — Lone Pine.

He died on active service.

✚ Captain B. S. GAYNOR.

Son of F. B. Gaynor Esq was born in Minta. Perak, Malay States on 2nd Nov. 1891. He attended state schools in Victoria and Tasmania, and also Melbourne Grammar School. Prior to enlisting he was an accountant, and a Lieut. in the Garrison Artillery, Sydney. Enlisting in Aug. 1914 he went into camp at Liverpool, N.S.W. and embarked with 2nd reinf. to 1st Div. Artillery on Jan. 20th 1915. Capt. Gaynor who fought on the Gallipoli and Somme fronts, was twice gassed, and also mentioned in Despatches. He returned to Australia on furlough aboard S.S. Niagara Nov. 1918. He then entered the Indian Army and was transferred to the 23rd Cavalry, being stationed at Meerut and Delhi, India.

He died on Nov. 1st 1920.

Pte. W. E. C. HATFIELD.

Son of D. A. Hatfield Esq. was born at Richmond on 24th Dec. 1892. He enlisted on 5th July 1915 and was in training Camps at Geelong and Broadmeadows. Was attached to 22nd Battⁿ and sailed on the S.S. Africa, 4th Jan. 1916, later being transferred to the 60th Battⁿ. He was engaged in battle of Fleurbaix, was twice wounded and embarked for Australia on S.S. Wiltshire which arrived at Melbourne on 31st December 1916.

Pte S.G. MOUNTJOY.

Son of W.A. Mountjoy Esq. was born in Lorne on June 25th 1887, attending Victorian state schools and Geelong College. Prior to enlistment he was manager of the local coach service.

Enlisting on 23rd May 1916, he was trained in camp at Maribyrnong. Was attached to 2nd Div. Amerⁿ Column and sailed in S.S. Ulysses on Oct. 25th 1916. He fought in engagements at Ypres, Villers Bretonneux, M^e St Quentin and other smaller battles.

Returned to Australia on 18th Aug. 1919 aboard S.S. Karmala.

Major S.A. MOUNTJOY

Son of W.A. Mountjoy was born in Lorne on 8th January 1889. He attended various schools in Victoria and Melbourne University graduating as a Licentiate of Veterinary Science.

Enlisting on Nov. 21st 1914 he was transferred to Aust. Army Vet. Corps and attached to 8th Light Horse Regt. and later H.Q. 3rd Light Horse Bde. Sailed overseas on S.S. Star of Victoria Feb. 25th 1915.

Major Mountjoy was with his units in all engagements through Sinai Desert, Palestine and Syrian campaigns, and later Egyptian Rising of 1919. He was "mentioned in despatches" during July 1918.

Returned to Victoria on S.S. Ypiranga 4th Feb. 1920 and is now practising as a veterinary surgeon.



Pte. E. ROMARO.

Enlisted on 31st. March
1915 and was trained
at Broadmeadows.

Sailed to Egypt on 7th
May 1915, and was
wounded, Sept. 1915,
and returned to Vict.
on 5th Feb. 1916.

He was discharged on
25th July 1916,
receiving a pension
as an invalid.

Died
May 27th 1921.



Pte R.C.A. SMITHERS.

Son of R. Smithers Esq. of Lorne
was born on the 18th Oct. 1892
and attended the Lorne school.

Enlisting on 10th April 1915,
he received his training in
camps at Seymour and —
Broadmeadows, embarking on
S.S. Demosthenes 16th July 1915,
with reinforcements to 5th Battalion,
being transferred later to the
58th Battⁿ.

Private Smithers fought on
Gallipoli and later at
Fleurbaix and Pozieres.

He was killed
in action on
19th July 1916.

Pte R.H. SMITHERS.

Son of K. Smithers Esq. was born on 26th May 1896, and attended the Lorne School.

He enlisted on 10th May 1915, and was trained in camps at Seymour and Broadmeadows, embarking with reinforcements to 14th Battⁿ on R.M.S. Persia Aug. 10th '15

Pte. Smithers fought on Gallipoli and battles of Pozieres, Flers, Bullecourt, Villers Bretonneux, and the advance in 1918, being wounded on 4 occasions.

He returned on S.S. Bakarra, which left Southampton on 4th Feb. 1919.

Pte V.K. SMITHERS.

Son of J. Smithers Esq., was born at Lorne in 1891. Prior to the war he was a farmer.

Enlisting on 16th May 1916 he was trained in camps at — Matibyzong Vict. and Larkhill, England, sailing on 28th Oct. 1916 aboard S.S. Ulysses.

Private Smithers was engaged in battles of Messines, Ypres, and the Somme.

He returned to Australia on S.S. Miltiades 20th May 1919.

Pte W.T. SMITHERS.

Son of R. Smithers Esq: was born at Deans Marsh on 25th Dec. 1882. Prior to enlisting he was a miner.

He proceeded overseas and was attached to the 49th Battⁿ.

He fought on —
Gallipoli and in
France & Belgium
returning to —
Australia on
17th April 1919.
